
Merit-based Incentive Payment System

Determining Participation in 2017

Don't Participate

Eligible clinicians who choose NOT to participate in MIPS by not submitting required data will receive a negative 4% Medicare Part B payment adjustment in 2019.

Test Pace

The test pace participation level is designed to help clinicians become familiar with the MIPS program.

Eligible clinicians must submit one quality measure for one patient for one day <u>OR</u> one improvement activity <u>OR</u> the required base measures for the Advancing Care Information (ACI) category.

Eligible clinicians only need to participate in one category (Quality, Improvement Activities, or Advancing Care Information) for 1 to 89 days to avoid a negative Medicare Part B payment adjustment in 2019.

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Determining Participation in 2017



Partial Participation

Eligible clinicians must submit six quality measures <u>AND</u> more than one improvement activity <u>AND</u> more than the required ACI base measures for at least 90 consecutive days. The consecutive 90 day period can start any time between January 1, 2017 and October 2, 2017.

Eligible clinicians who participated in Meaningful Use, Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) or Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) should be in a good position to submit required data and will have the opportunity to earn a positive Medicare Part B payment adjustment in 2019.



Full Participation

Eligible clinicians must submit six quality measures <u>AND</u> more than one improvement activity <u>AND</u> more than the required ACI base measures from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

Eligible clinicians who participated in Meaningful Use, Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) or Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) should be in a good position to submit required data and will have the opportunity to earn a positive Medicare Part B payment adjustment in 2019.
