### About Us



NYC REACH is the primary care technical assistance arm of the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH). Our mission is to support safety net providers to deliver high quality, person-centered, tech-enabled, anti-racist care. We have provided PCMH technical assistance since 2010.

### By the Numbers



We have supported **over 750+** primary care sites to achieve and sustain PCMH recognition. From 2018 to 2020, we supported **287** sites to transform to the NYS PCMH model through a NYS State Innovation Model (SIM) grant. Currently, we support **259** primary care practice sites in NYC to sustain PCMH best practices and PCMH recognition each year through our *PCMH Sustainability Program*. **100%** of the practices that participate in this program have sustained PCMH recognition.

### Current Programming



Our **free PCMH Sustainability Program** provides workshops and roundtable events; each of these helps attendees learn about PCMH requirements, workflow best practices, and quality improvement approaches. Our **PCMH Paid Services Program** includes 1:1 technical assistance for annual reporting, documentation review, and audit support, as well as a variety of tools and templates in NYC REACH's *PCMH Playbook*. New for 2025, we are offering a *Preconception Care in the PCMH* training.

Our Care Transformation Specialists are recognized by NCQA as Certified Content Experts (PCMH CCEs). All are experienced in practice facilitation and have a collective 49 years' experience providing PCMH technical assistance. NYC REACH is an NCQA Partner in Quality.
