Dementia Risk Screening and Identification

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Identify and Screen Patient

- **Identification techniques:** [10 Warning Signs of Dementia](#) and Annual Wellness Visit
- **Cognitive screens:** [Mini-COG](#), [MIS](#), and [AD8](#)
- **Depression screening:** [PHQ-9](#) or [Geriatric Depression Scale](#)
- **Substance use:** Alcohol, smoking, or other substance use; [AUDIT](#), [CAGE](#)

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Identify care partner or caregiver and assess needs

- Obtain information about patient from informants (i.e., caregivers, family, etc.)
- Screen for neuropsychiatric symptoms (e.g., depression) and caregiver burden ([ZARIT Burden Interview](#))

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Identify patient needs and assess safety

- **Functional assessment:** [ADLs](#) and [IADLs](#)
- [Medicare Annual Wellness Packet](#)

Particular focus on medication administration, travel (including driving), meal preparation, possession of a firearm

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Formulate and discuss clinical diagnosis impressions

- **No cognitive impairment:** Discuss preventive measures
- **Mild cognitive impairment or dementia:** Discuss the diagnosis and recommend lab testing and brain imaging
